Re: <u>Scrutinizer's Report on Postal Ballot Notice dated 13th February, 2016</u> seeking approval of the shareholders u/s 110 of the Companies Act, 2013

In terms of the resolution passed by the Board of Directors of J C T Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'the Company') at its meeting held on 13th February, 2016, I have been appointed as Scrutinizer to receive, process and scrutinize the postal ballot papers and e-voting in respect of Special Resolutions proposed in the Postal Ballot Notice dated 13th February, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Postal Ballot Notice').

- 'Daily Nawan Jamana' and 'Financial Express' newspapers on 22nd February, 2016.
- 4. All Postal Ballot Forms received up to Wednesday, the 23rd March, 2016 (5.00 P.M.) (being the last date for receipt of Postal Ballot Forms) were considered for my scrutiny.
- 5. The particulars of e-voting done by the members of the Company during the period from Monday, February 22nd, 2016 (9.00 A.M.) till Wednesday, March 23rd, 2016 (05.00 P.M.) by logging on on-line E-voting site of NSDL were considered for my scrutiny.
- 6. Particulars of all Postal Ballot Forms received from the members of the Company, including e-voting, have been entered in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
- 7. No Envelope containing Postal Ballot Forms was received after Wednesday, the 23rd March, 2016 (5.00 P.M.) (being the last date for receipt of Postal Ballot Forms).
- 8. I did not find any defaced or mutilated Postal Ballot Form.
- 9. No member has cast votes both in postal ballot form and by way of e-voting.
