Re: <u>Scrutinizer's Report on Postal Ballot Notice dated 14th November, 2014</u> seeking approval of the shareholders u/s 110 of the Companies Act, 2013

- All Postal Ballot Forms received up to Friday, the 6th February, 2015 (5.30 P.M.) (being the last date for receipt of Postal Ballot Forms) were considered for my scrutiny.
- 5. The particulars of e-voting done by the members of the Company during the period from Wednesday, January 7, 2015 (9.00 A.M.) till Friday, February 6, 2015 (05.30 P.M.) by logging on on-line E-voting site of NSDL were considered for my scrutiny.
- 6. Particulars of all Postal Ballot Forms received from the members of the Company, including e-voting, have been entered in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
- No Envelope containing Postal Ballot Forms was received after Friday, the 6th February, 2015 (5.30 P.M.) (being the last date for receipt of Postal Ballot Forms).
- 8. I did not find any defaced or mutilated Postal Ballot Form.
- No member has cast votes both in postal ballot form and by way of e-voting.
